Dear Parents and Carers

Re: Curricular Enrichment Activities – Autumn 2024

I am writing to let you know about a comprehensive range of curricular enrichment clubs which will be taking place during the Autumn Term. A timetable is attached for your information. We aim to provide a broad range of activities that will appeal to all children's interests and hope that they take advantage of all that is on offer.

This term we will be using a Google form to sign up for clubs on line. The link to the Extra Curricular Club form is at the foot of this letter. This online form will be 'live' on Wednesday 18th September at 5.00pm. You will not be able to complete the online form before this time. Please complete the form to request up to two lunchtime clubs and two after school clubs. The form will be live at 5.00pm on Wednesday 18th September and will close on Friday 20th September at 8.30am. After this time, you will not be able to access the form. As before, places will be allocated on a first come first serve basis.

Please note teacher led clubs will commence from **Monday 30th September** your child will **only** be told if they are **unsuccessful** in joining a club and their name will be added to the waiting list. Teacher led clubs will run until w/c **2nd December**.

The clubs that are run by outside providers such as Martin Sheppard Football, Dodgeball, Wild Art, Forest Forge, Orchestra, Fresh Air and The Performing Arts Academy require an additional payment. Please contact these clubs directly (except Orchestra). The flyers for these clubs are attached.

Clubs are run on a termly basis and although most will continue to run throughout the school year, some will change along with the seasons. Children will need to sign up each term for their chosen club. Do take time to look through the timetable of curricular clubs and talk to your child about the days and timings of the different clubs. There is a Clubs' Noticeboard which is located just outside the hall and we shall be posting details about each club for your information. If, however, you would like additional information or have a specific query, then please contact Mrs James, in the school office, or the member of staff running the club, via the school office.

It is important that once a club has been selected, then children show their commitment by attending each week. They need to be punctual and take responsibility for having the right equipment and kit. Unfortunately, we do not have spare kit so if children forget their belongings then they still need to attend the club, where they will help the leader. This is important as we need to account for all children who have signed up for a club. Should a child not be staying for any reason, we require a written note from you. If a child does not attend the club for two weeks in a row, they will automatically be removed from the club.



Please note that all children who attend an after-school club run by the teachers, will need to be collected from the main school reception area. If your child is attending a club run by an outside provider, you will need to check with the club where you should collect your child from. Every effort will be made to inform you if a club has to be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances. An email message will be sent as the first communication.

The majority of clubs are run on a voluntary basis by teachers at the school. I am sure you would like to join me in thanking our committed staff who give freely of their time to enhance the educational opportunities for our children.
