

As a governor, you will be a volunteer who makes a vital contribution to the success of the school, and we would be delighted to welcome a member of the Ringwood Community to take up a post.

Becoming a school governor requires drive and commitment, but you'll also enjoy many professional and personal rewards, including skills development opportunities and the chance to support young people's futures.



WHAT IS A SCHOOL GOVERNOR?

School governors have a varied and important role, in helping our school run effectively.

The governing body's main tasks are:

- to ensure that the school has a clear vision, ethos and strategic direction;
- to hold the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils;
- to oversee the financial performance of the school, making sure money is well spent.

The governor's role is strategic rather than operational. Governors don't get involved with the day-to-day running of the school, instead supporting and challenging the school's leadership team to drive school improvement, and champion the work the school does.

OUR GOVERNING BOARD

Our full board meets 6 times per year, usually on a Thursday evening, generally in person but sometimes via Teams. We also have several committees and governors are invited to join at least one; finance, curriculum & standards, inclusions, environment, health & safety and personnel.

Being a school governor is a commitment and a responsibility, but offers you the chance to see first-hand the impact you can make in improving education for children in our community. No special qualifications are needed; the most important thing is to have a keen interest and be prepared to play an active part in the governing body's work.



OUR SCHOOL

Ringwood Junior School is a vibrant and welcoming school on the edge of the New Forest with approximately 380 pupils, organised into 12 classes across 4 school years.
