Ringwood Junior School is a vibrant and welcoming school on the edge of the New Forest, with approximately 360 pupils organised into 12 classes.

We are seeking two Parent Governors to join the governing body.

As a governor you will be a volunteer who makes a vital contribution to the success of the school.

The role would suit someone who has a background in education, business, finance, health and safety or personnel. We welcome applications from anyone with the enthusiasm and an interest to effectively challenge and support the school.

The governing board meets six times a year usually on a Thursday evening. In addition, governors are asked to join one of the sub-committees which also meet regularly throughout the year. Governors have access to an extensive training programme through the local authority, either in person or online, and are encouraged to attend regular training sessions.

The governing body's main tasks are:

- to ensure that the school has a clear vision, ethos and strategic direction;
- to hold the headteacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils;
- to oversee the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent.

Parent governors are welcomed as valued members of the team and play a vital role in ensuring the governing body is aware of the views of parents and the local community. We feel sure that there are parents prepared to take on this important role and give their time and commitment to helping us to continue to improve the school's performance.

You must be over 18 to apply and all governors must have a Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check.
