Dear Parents and Carers

### **Re: Curricular Enrichment Activities – Spring 2026**

I am writing to let you know about a comprehensive range of curricular enrichment clubs which will be taking place during the Spring Term. A timetable is attached for your information. We aim to provide a broad range of activities that will appeal to all children's interests and hope that they take advantage of all that is on offer.

We are using Arbor this term to sign up for clubs. Once you have been accepted into an after school club, payment will then be available via scopyay.

Please register your child for no more than two lunch time clubs and two after school clubs. Please be advised clubs are non refundable.

Teacher led clubs will run for 8 weeks from w/c 19<sup>th</sup> January 2026 to 16<sup>th</sup> March 2026. As per last term, there is a small charge of £2.00 per week for after school clubs, no charge for lunch time clubs. Please ensure this is paid before the club starts in order to secure the place.

Clubs will be available to book **on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> December at 6.00pm**. Please note if you are unable to book onto a club, it will mean all spaces have been filled, however do contact the school office to be added to the waiting list.

The clubs that are run by outside providers such as Dodgeball, Wild Art and Fresh Air, please contact these clubs directly. Orchestra is available for children in years 4-6 who have played an instrument for a year. Please email [admin.office@ringwood-junior.hants.sch.uk](mailto:admin.office@ringwood-junior.hants.sch.uk) to book a space.

Clubs are run on a termly basis and although most will continue to run throughout the school year, some will change along with the seasons. Children will need to sign up each term for their chosen club. Do take time to look through the timetable of curricular clubs and talk to your child about the days and timings of the different clubs. There is a Clubs' Noticeboard which is located just outside the hall and we shall be posting details about each club for your information. If, however, you would like additional information or have a specific query, then please contact Mrs James, in the school office, or the member of staff running the club, via the school office.

It is important that once a club has been selected, then children show their commitment by attending each week as we will not be offering refunds for any after school clubs. Children need to be punctual and take responsibility for having the right equipment and kit. Unfortunately, we do not have spare kit so if children forget their belongings then they still need to attend the club, where they will help the leader. This is important as we need to account for all children who have signed up for a club. Should a child not be staying for any reason, we require a written note from you.



Please note that all children who attend an after school club run by the teachers, will need to be collected from the main school reception area. If your child is attending a club run by an outside provider, you will need to check with the club where you should collect your child from. Every effort will be made to inform you if a club has to be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances. An email message will be sent as the first communication.
