### **Year 6 Activities Week 15<sup>th</sup> June – 19<sup>th</sup> June 2026**

During the week of 15<sup>th</sup> June to 19<sup>th</sup> June 2026, some of the children in year 6 will be going to Barton Hall, Torquay for a residential trip. We have arranged a week of fun activities for the children remaining in school.

On **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June**, we shall be having an outdoor activity day. This includes a **climbing wall** on the back playground in the morning and after lunch, we will be going to **Ringwood Leisure Centre** for a **fun swim** session. Please remember to pack your child's swimming kit.

On **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> June**, we would like to walk the children to **Moors Valley** along the Castleman Way, to take part in the **Go Ape Tree Top Adventure**. We aim to leave school by 9.00am and return by 3.00pm. The children may bring some money to purchase an ice cream if they wish (we recommend approximately £5). Please bring appropriate outdoor wear including a lightweight waterproof jacket and sturdy walking shoes. They will require a packed lunch and plenty of water: a rucksack would also be recommended.

On **Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June**, we shall be taking part in outdoor activities with Mr Blake.

On **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> June**, we will be spending the day at **Butchers Coppice** to take part in rifle shooting, trampoline and gladiator challenge. A coach will take the children from school to Butchers Coppice and return back to school for 3pm. They will also need to bring a packed lunch and a drink (no glass bottles please).

The children may wear appropriate outdoor clothing for Moors Valley and Butchers Coppice– long trousers are recommended, sensible footwear, hats and sun cream if weather permits.

On **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June**, in the morning, we will be **making pizzas** together. We will provide some ingredients including the dough, tomato sauce, cheese, ham and mushrooms. If your child would like to bring in other ingredients, they are welcome to do so. They may eat the pizza in school, or alternatively, bring in a container to take it home.

On **Friday afternoon**, we will be having an outdoor party at school with a bouncy castle **provided by the school's PTA**.

The children may wear their own, suitable clothes to school during the week.



If you have any concerns, please contact the school office. We are sure this will be a varied and fun week for all.

We would request a contribution of £60.00 to help towards the cost of the activities. The school is dependent on these voluntary contributions, so unfortunately, if insufficient contributions are received, it will not be viable for the trips and activities to go ahead. **Please contact the school office if you are concerned about payments or would like to set up a payment plan and we will do our best to support you.**
