### **Sports Day – Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June**

We are delighted to invite you to Sports Day on **Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June**. The aim is to provide all of our children with an opportunity to enjoy sporting activities and exercise on an inclusive and competitive basis, whilst helping to improve their health, fitness and varied athletic skills.

Sports Day will begin with the **initial track heats** held in the afternoon at the Pavilion Sports field for each year group as follows:

Year 3: Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May

Year 4: Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May

Year 5: Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> May

Year 6: Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May

These heats dates are for your information only. **Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school each week, as normal, in case of changes due to inclement weather.** These heats will determine which competitive races children will be participating in during the afternoon of sports day.

Sports day itself will be organised into two parts with each child accumulating points for their respective houses. The morning session will take the form of an all-inclusive athletic programme. The children will take part in their classes and score points for their houses in a series of field events, whilst moving from activity station to activity station. We hope that this format will give all of our children a chance to take part in every activity, whilst helping to contribute to the team spirit of competing for the House Trophy.

During the afternoon, children will be organised into house groups and will continue to collect house points, on an individual basis during the Sports Day track events, the finals of the heats. These will be added to house points collected throughout the morning. The winning house will be announced at the end of the day, when the house representatives will be presented with a cup.

### **End of School Day Arrangements**

Parents will be able to collect their child from the playing field after the sports have ended and must ensure that their child is signed out with the class teacher. We shall make every effort to finish on time.

Any children not collected from the field will return to school with staff, to be dismissed as normal at 3pm. Those attending 115 After School Club will return with class teachers to 115 staff on the school site.
